

Minute of Stepps Chess Club AGM – held on Thursday, 5/10/17

at 7.15 in Stepps Culutural Centre

Secretary's Report: Drew Pollock noted that this had been Stepps CC least successful season to date – with the winning of the Dunbartonshire Knock Out and promotion to Division 1 of the National League the main successes.

Treasurer's Report: A balance sheet was distributed, showing that the club had a slightly poorer balance from previous year. This was healthy enough but this would be impacted by a new team in Division 3 of the GCL, increased costs due to the need to book a second room for busy nights at the club. The treasurer recommended an increase in club fees to £50 (employed adults), £25 (senior citizens) and £10 for juniors (unchanged). After some discussion this was approved by the meeting.
